## Our weekly meetings

Our regular meetings take place on Wednesday afternoons from 1.45pm to 4.45pm at Broadway House, 4-8 The Broadway, Northbrook Street, Newbury, RG14 1BA (Conference Room G9).

A typical meeting comprises:

- Group round-robin
- Workshop on a job-seeking topic (see below)
- Discussion groups sharing experiences
- Networking with other members
- Individual guidance (on request)

The formal session usually ends at around 3.30pm. Then there are networking opportunities or sometimes a short 'mini-session' on a related topic. A typical 3-month programme covers the following:

- Preparation coping with redundancy, preparing your CV, "tell me about yourself"
- Marketing yourself responding to adverts, how to work with recruiters (e.g. agencies), what employer's look for, the hidden job market, networking, making direct approaches
- Taking action the interview, telephone technique
- Mini-sessions Volunteering, CV Masterclass, LinkedIn etc.
